

Advantages of a Transportation Agreement

Quality service for your employees. When you hire a new employee or transfer an existing one, you can assure them that their first experiences with United Van Lines will be handled by qualified moving professionals. Cash Back Reimbursement. New and current employees may be eligible in receiving cash back in the selling and purchasing of their homes. The selection of a realtor must go through United Van Lines, City Pointe Program prior to listing and purchasing of homes.

Priority service. All relocations for our national accounts receive priority over individually booked moves. If blackout days are scheduled due to peak volume, your moves are not affected.

Fixed Rates. Moving rates and discounts are fixed over the term of the agreement. During our busiest season of May 15 to September 30, peak charges are waived. That can be a savings to you of 10% to 12% or \$500 to \$1000 per move during the summer months.

Free full replacement valuation. Under a transportation agreement your employees will receive full replacement valuation, the highest level of protection at no charge. This could save you from \$250 to \$750 per move.

More productive employees. You will have more productive employees, because we can save them and their families a lot of time and stress. Only one person will come into their home to do a survey. They don't have to waste time setting up appointments and taking time off work for multiple quotes. We are their one point of contact and make all the arrangements from the preliminary survey through carton removal at their new home.

Levels of service. A transportation agreement can accommodate different tiers of service depending on the level of staff. For example, you may want to provide packing services for some employees, but not for others. We will explain to employees what services are provided under the relocation policy for their tier.

Less work for you. You will save time because all you need to do is email us with the employee's name, tier of service and phone number. We contact them and make all the arrangements. If they have any questions regarding their relocation, we are the first point of contact.

Save money. You will save money by eliminating unauthorized items. We provide only the services you identify when we prepare the transportation agreement, unless we have prior approval.

Accurate invoices. Before you receive an invoice from us, we will conduct a complete audit of the charges. When you see our signature at the bottom, you know it is accurate.

No minimum and no obligation. There is no minimum number of moves required to take advantage of a transportation agreement with United Van Lines. If you have just one interstate move, you can benefit. It is not an exclusive contract, so you have no obligation to use United Van Lines. However, we are confident that after one move under our transportation agreement, you and your new employees will find that the service and benefits far exceed your expectations, and that you will come to us for every move.
